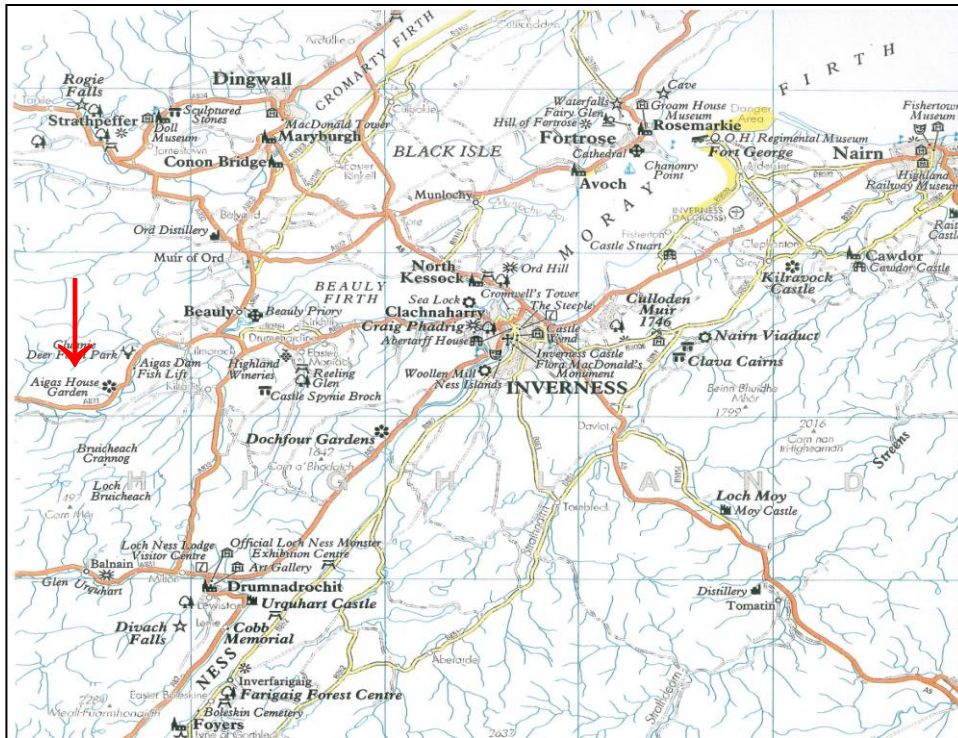


AIGAS HOUSE & FIELD CENTRE



The easiest way to get to Aigas by avoiding Inverness City is to follow the signs for the Kessock Bridge and carry on up the A9 until you reach Tore roundabout. Take the first turning on your left and head towards Muir of Ord.

After about 6 miles take a left turn and follow the signs for Beauly. Go through Beauly and take the turn off to Aigas (A831 - Cannich) which is a sharp bend to the right. Drive up this road for approx. 4 miles. Drive past the Crask of Aigas (on the right) and down the hill where you'll see the golf course and the large house.

We're the second entrance on your right, immediately past the golf course, to Aigas Field Centre. Drive over the two cattle grids and follow the sign to the visitor's car park where you park. Walk up through the garage and up to the front door of the house. We look forward to welcoming you there.
